A workshop on the importance of Letters of Recommendation (LOR) for students applying to institutions in the United States was organised for teachers and counsellors of Amity by Amity Career Counseling and Guidance Cell (ACCGC) on June 28, 2024. Held in hybrid mode under the visionary leadership of Dr (Mrs) Amita Chauhan, Chairperson, Amity Group of Schools & RBEF, the session was led by Bhavna Jolly from the United States-India Educational Foundation (USIEF). The workshop aimed at acquaint-

ing participants about the pivotal role Letters of Recommendation (LOR) in the application process of universities in the USA and to guide them for creating impactful recommendations. During the workshop, a framework for writing LORs (what I know, how I know, why I am telling this) was shared. Other key topics discussed were teacher LORs, counselor LORs, essential qualities, writing tips, templates and resources. Do's and don'ts of writing LORs, samples, importance of storytelling in LOR writing was also shared.
