Covert gear & gadgets

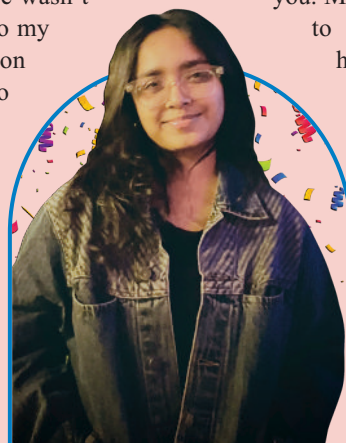
Sample papers and previous years' question papers gave me a good understanding of the boards' pattern and helped me pace myself during the actual exam.

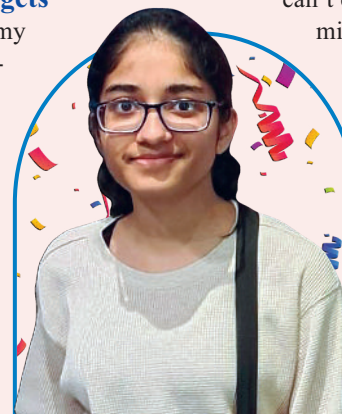
Scoring top marks was an incredibly joyous moment. It felt like all the effort I had put in had finally paid off. But the best part was seeing how happy my parents and teachers were.
